ADENOIDECTOMY POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- Mild discomfort after your surgery is not uncommon
 - For pain relief: take Panadol or Panadeine Forte or Pain Stop as prescribed (DO NOT take aspirin due to the increased risk of bleeding)
 - Non-steroidal anti-inflammatories (eg Brufen) can also be taken if the pain is very bad
- If there is bleeding from the nose or mouth then spray the nose with a nasal decongestant spray (Otrivine or Drixine)
 - If the bleeding does not quickly settle then call the rooms or go to your nearest major hospital Emergency Department to be assessed
- It is recommended that you/your child have 5 days off school or work and no sport or heavy lifting (more than a chair) for 2 weeks
